



## 2009 KTM CANADA AMATEUR / PRO AM CONTINGENCY PROGRAM

<b>PROGRAM</b>	<p>The <b>2009 KTM CANADA AMATEUR / PRO AM MX CONTINGENCY PROGRAM</b> is strictly available to Amateur / PRO Am motocross classes. Only 2007, 2008 and 2009 Canadian KTM models purchased and registered in Canada (125 SX, 144 SX, 150 SX, 250 SX, 250 SX-F, 450 SX-F, 505 SX-F) are eligible.</p> <p>KTM Canada, Inc. will only pay contingency in the specified Series /Classes as listed in the <b>2009 KTM CANADA AMATEUR / PRO AM MX CONTINGENCY PROGRAM PAY OUT SCHEDULE</b> within the specific time period between May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 to October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009.</p> <p>The <b>2009 KTM CANADA AMATEUR / PRO AM MX CONTINGENCY PROGRAM</b> will be exclusively paid on Series overall championship results. For Amateurs, payment will be issued via <b>KTM CASH</b> voucher redeemable for KTM parts, clothing &amp; accessories at participating authorized Canadian KTM Dealers (not redeemable for cash money). For competitors in the Provincial Pro classes, payment will be issued via <b>KTM CHEQUE</b> to the rider's name.</p>
<b>WHAT TO DO</b>	<p>To be eligible KTM riders must be registered with KTM Canada, Inc. by completing and submitting the <b>2009 KTM CANADA MX CONTINGENCY PROGRAM REGISTRATION FORM</b> available at your participating authorized KTM dealer in Canada or on our web site: <a href="http://www.ktmcanada.com">www.ktmcanada.com</a>.</p> <p>Registration form can be mailed to: KTM Canada, Inc., 1375-1 Marie-Victorin, St-Bruno, Quebec, J3V 6B7 or faxed to 450-441-3885. KTM Canada, Inc. must receive all registrations no later than May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009. Registrations submitted after May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 will not be eligible.</p> <p>Registered riders will receive a confirmation e-mail from <a href="mailto:KTMCanadaCommunications@ktmnorthamerica.com">KTMCanadaCommunications@ktmnorthamerica.com</a>.</p>
<b>RULES AND REGULATIONS</b>	<p>It is the rider's responsibility to resolve eventual race result disputes with the race organizations.</p> <p>Riders falsifying claims will be automatically disqualified from the program.</p> <p>Only motorcycles containing a genuine Canadian KTM Vehicle Identification Number are eligible.</p> <p>Only riders with valid Canadian address and social insurance number will be eligible.</p> <p>Aftermarket plastics and graphics are permitted as long as the KTM logo is displayed in a manner that is acceptable by KTM Canada, Inc.</p> <p><b>KTM CASH</b> vouchers and <b>KTM CHEQUES</b> will be issued once overall racing results are validated by the race promoters or sanctioning bodies. Please allow at least 4 weeks for overall verification of results and issuing of payments. Please note that all payments will be issued by end of December, 2009.
