

SAFETY WARNING FOR KTM MOTOCROSS AND ENDURO MODELS!

KTM issues a safety warning to owners of certain Motocross and Enduro models advising them to have the tank cap exchanged at their earliest convenience.

Under certain circumstances it is possible that if customers do not properly secure the tank cap, or if it is bumped by the knee, it may open and become lost. This can result in a loss of fuel with the obvious negative effects. The replacement tank cap is fitted with a special locking mechanism that prevents this problem.

This Safety Warning covers the following models:

Motocross MY 2006: 250 SX-F, 250 SXS-F

MY 2007: 125/144/250 SX, 125 SXS, 250/450/505 SX-F

Enduro MY 2006: 250/300/450 XC, 300 XC-W and 450/525 EXC

MY 2007: 250/300/450/525 EXC, 250 EXC-F, 300 EXC-E, 200/250/300/450 XC, 250/450 XCF-W, 200/250/300/525 XC-W

All owners of the motorcycles affected should immediately exchange the tank cap for a modified locking tank cap free of charge at any official KTM partner.

This official KTM Sportmotorcycle AG safety warning is being made public in the form of a press release, it is being communicated to national offroad clubs and will be published in the official KTM magazine "Ready to Race" (Nov.2007). It will also be displayed in a prominent place at the premises of KTM dealers.

In addition, all owners have the possibility to check online to see whether their vehicle is affected by the safety warning by going to the "Service" area of www.ktm.com and entering the chassis number and the delivery certificate number.
