The voluntary exchange program affects CONTINENTAL 120/70 ZR 17 and 120/70 R 17 motorcycle front wheel tires. The condition in the tread and/ or belt may lead to separation and possible pressure loss. Therefore, CONTINENTAL offers an exchange program that covers approximately 170,000 tires sold worldwide between 2007 and 2014.

The CONTINENTAL tire manufacturer started a voluntary tire exchange program on August 11, covering around 170,000 motorcycle tires of the sizes 120/70 ZR 17 and 120/70 R 17. According to CONTINENTAL, market feedback indicates that a very small number of these tires have exhibited a condition in the tread and/ or belt which may lead to separation and possible air loss. The exchange program is being initiated by CONTINENTAL to avoid any potential risk to road-users. The affected tires were manufactured between 2007 and 2014 and were primarily sold to replacement customers. It is also possible, however, that tires mounted as original equipment are affected by this program.
